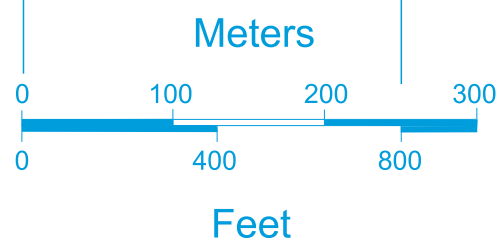
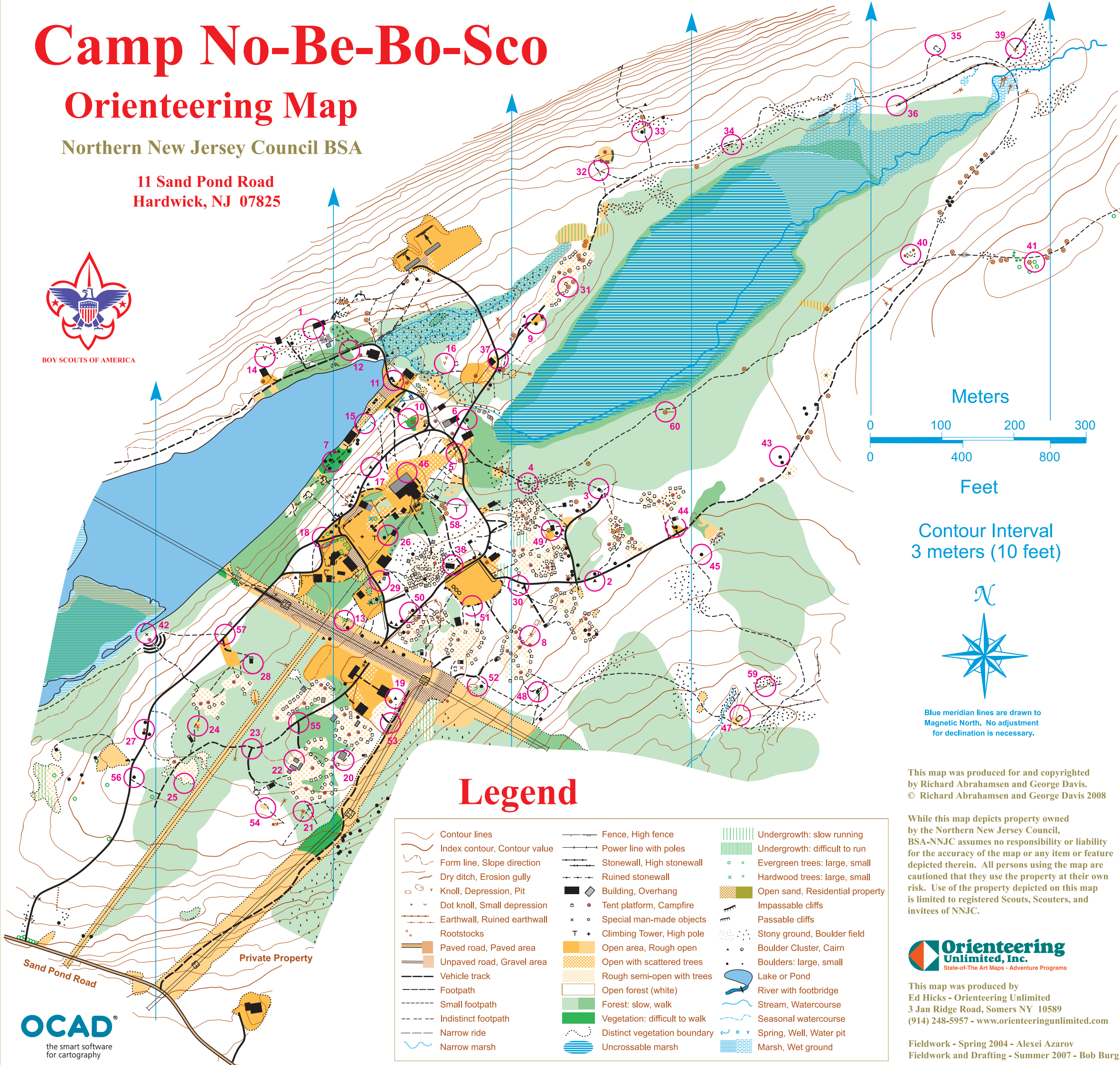

Index contour, Contour value	Power line with poles	Undergrowth: difficult to run
Form line, Slope direction	Stonewall, High stonewall	Evergreen trees: large, small
Dry ditch, Erosion gully	Ruined stonewall	Hardwood trees: large, small
Knoll, Depression, Pit	Building, Overhang	Open sand, Residential property
Dot knoll, Small depression	Tent platform, Campfire	Impassable cliffs
Earthwall, Ruined earthwall	Special man-made objects	Passable cliffs
Rootstocks	Climbing Tower, High pole	Stony ground, Boulder field
Paved road, Paved area	Open area, Rough open	Boulder Cluster, Cairn
Unpaved road, Gravel area	Open with scattered trees	Boulders: large, small
Vehicle track	Rough semi-open with trees	Lake or Pond
Footpath	Open forest (white)	River with footbridge
Small footpath	Forest: slow, walk	Stream, Watercourse
Indistinct footpath	Vegetation: difficult to walk	Seasonal watercourse
Narrow ride	Distinct vegetation boundary	Spring, Well, Water pit
Narrow marsh	Uncrossable marsh	Marsh, Wet ground
